




1. Press anywhere on this screen to begin powering up the AV system.



2. During startup, the system is sequentially turning on AV equipment, initializing volume levels, and setting video routes. A countdown timer is displayed to indicate the progress of the startup sequence.



3. Choose a video/audio source to route to a destination. (See “Main: Source Selection” for detailed information on routing controls). Sources are displayed in two separate groups: “Lectern Sources” for sources associated with the instructor location and “Pod Sources” for the individual group input locations around the room.

Source Select – Choose a video/audio source to route to a destination. (In-room computer, presenter’s laptop, wireless connection, and Blu-ray)

Program Volume – Adjust the volume of the source that is currently routed to the room’s speaker system.

System Shutdown – Display option to shut down the system.




4. Main: Source Selection


Press the desired source button in the “Source Select” pane to select a video source to route. The selected source will be highlighted. Contextual information about the source will be displayed on the right (i.e. Blu-ray controls are available when Blu-ray is the selected source).

In the “Choose destination:” portion of the page, select which destinations to route the selected source to. The current source is indicated in text below each destination button. All destinations that are currently set to the selected source will also be highlighted.

Tip: To quickly send a source to ALL destinations, simply hold down any destination button for 3 seconds. This same functionality also applies for the “Mute” and “Clear” buttons.




5. Pressing the power button in the top right of the panel will prompt the user to confirm shutdown of the system. Select “Yes” to start shutdown, or “No” to return to the main page. A 30 second timer will begin for automatic shutdown of the system – if the timer elapses, the system will shutdown. If “No” is selected, the automatic shutdown timer is canceled.



Solstice

This room is equipped with the Solstice system which allows for wireless connection to the displays. The following image is an **example** of what the Solstice screen looks like. The numbers will differ for each room/display.



How to use Solstice:

1. Connect your device to IllinoisNet or IllinoisNet_guest
2. Browse to the following for each display:

3. Connect using the 4-digit room code on the screen (i.e., 6320)
4. Apple users can AirPlay to the number displayed on the screen (i.e.336) after connecting via the Solstice app. Then enter the 4-digit room code.

Please, remember to shut down the system and press DISPLAY OFF when finished.
