

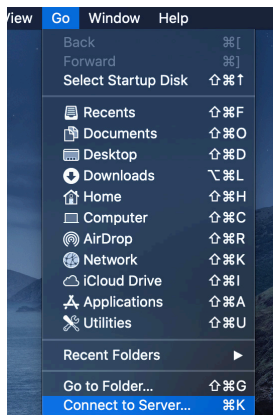
Accessing the College of Media Server from Off-Campus

To access the server from off-campus you need two things.

1. UIUC VPN connection signed in and set to “3_TunnelALL”
2. Course network folder address storage02.media.edu (Connect using the Windows and Mac instructions Below)

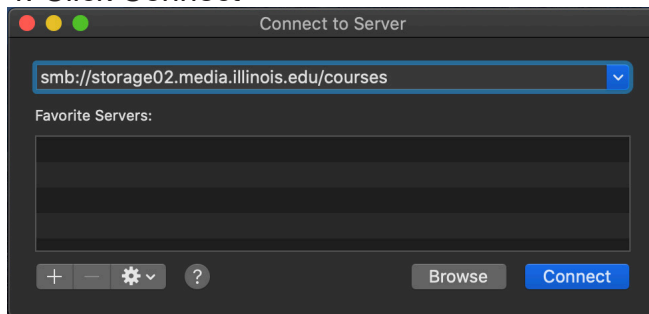
MAC

1. Click Go
2. Connect to Server

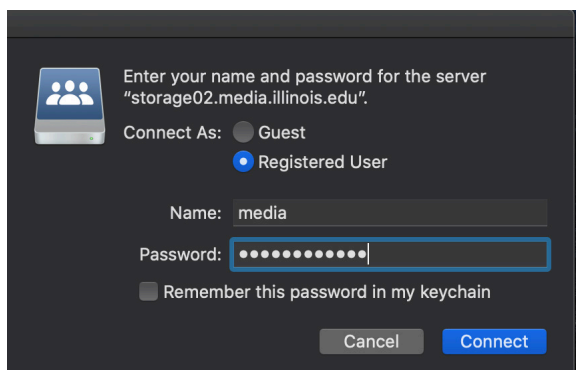


3. Enter the address smb://storage02.media.illinois.edu/courses

4. Click Connect



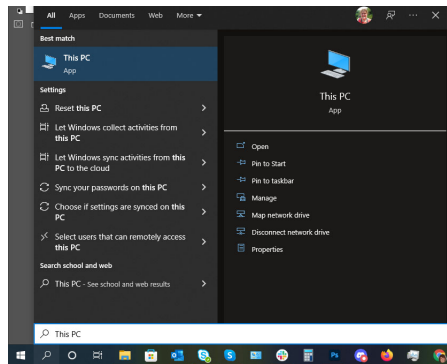
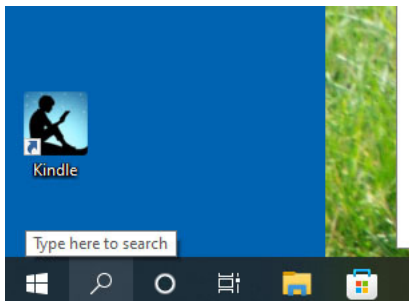
5. Ensure 'registered user' is selected and enter yournetid & Password



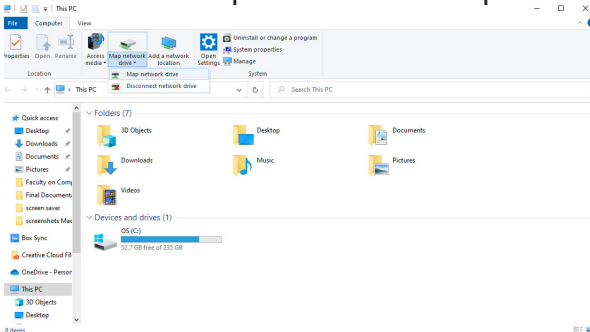
6. click connect and select your course from the populated folders

Windows

1. From the Windows desktop click in the box “type here to search” and type in: this PC and click enter



2. Click the computer tab at the top and click on “Map Network Drive”



3. Enter the folder address \\storage02.media.illinois.edu\courses\
